At some point between 715 BC and 45 BC the Romans placed Ianuarius as the first month of the year.

**When Ianuarius (January) was placed as the first month of the year, it bumped Sept, Oct, Nov, and Dec to the 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th months of the year.
This is the point where the months went out of sync with the meaning of their names.**

Year of Confusion in 46 BC had 445 days. Two leap months were added for calendar reform purposes. Leap day added in Februarius.

**Quintilus renamed as Iulius (July) in honor of Julius Caesar in 45 BC.
Sextilus renamed as Augustus in honor of Augustus Caesar in 8BC.
By the twelfth century England and parts of Europe used March 25 as the New Year date.**

Although the Gregorian calendar is named after Pope Gregory XIII, it is an adaptation of a calendar designed by Italian doctor, astronomer, and philosopher Luigi Lilio (also known as Aloysius Lilius). Luigi was born around 1510 AD and passed in 1576 AD, six years before his calendar was accepted in 1582 AD.

Main difference between Julian and Gregorian is calculation of leap years.

In 1752 AD England and colonies switched to the Gregorian calendar.

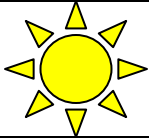
Alpha Omega Leap Day is 0/1 which is the day after the New Year Day

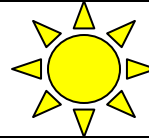

HOLY BIBLE JESUS CHRIST CRUCIFIXION RESURRECTION STORY

Jesus came to Jerusalem on Palm Tuesday, March 10, as the Passover Lamb. After Passover evening on March 14, the disciples prepared for **Jesus** to celebrate the Last Supper from Sunday evening March 15 into Monday morning March 16 where **Jesus** was taken away to be on trial during the week up until Good Friday, March 20, when the people crucified him. **Jesus** was in the tomb on Saturday the high holy day Sabbath seventh day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, March 21, and then rose again on Easter Sunday, March 22, being seen 40 days to Ascension Day Thursday, April 31, and then 10 days later was Pentecost Sunday, May 10, and the birth of the Church.
